









MULTI-ENGINE PISTON RATING (MEP)

Cost Breakdown

The course is conducted on a Diamond DA42 NG Multi-engine Aircraft.

Min 6 hours flying time: £3,600 (6 hours @ £600 per hour)

Course Book: Approximately £20

7 hours Ground School: £350 (7 hours at £50 per hour)

1 x Ground Theory Exam: £40 (sat in the school)

Practical Skills Test: £250 Examiner Fee + Aircraft Hire @ £540 per hour (Approximately 1 hour)

Other costs to think about:

Circuits Fees: When you visit other aerodromes they will charge for these. Estimate around £150

to cover the cost, however, the number of circuits you will do is performance-based.

CAA Fees: When processing your application, the CAA will charge you a fee. This will be around

£131 to have the rating added to your licence, plus a courier fee of around £15. See the CAA Scheme of charges on their website at the time of your application for an

accurate cost.

Membership: £20 per month (or £140 a year upfront).

Headset: Due to Covid-19, it is now mandatory to have your own headset.

Pre-Requisites:

The following requirements will need to be met prior to the commencement of training:

- You need to be a holder of at least a PPL (A) or CPL (A) with an SEP rating.
- At least 70 hours SEP Pilot in Command since the issue of the licence.
- Hold a valid Class 1 or 2 Medical.

All stated training hours are the minimum required by the regulatory authority before applying for a skills test. Weather, aircraft serviceability and personal learning capacity may increase the duration of the course.
